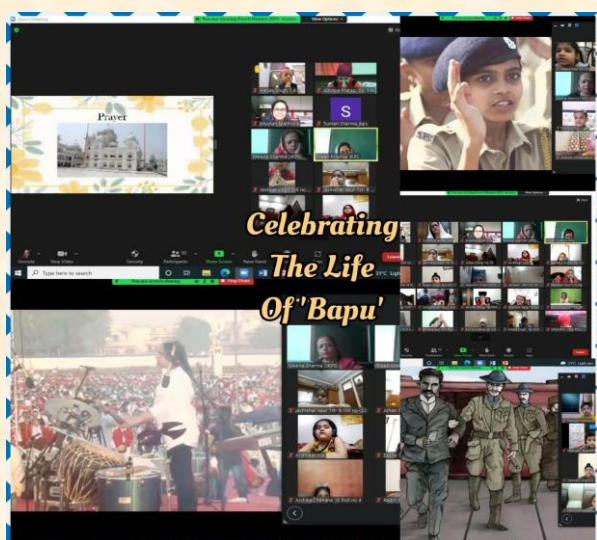
CLASS I, II, III

The assembly came to an emotional end when the children and their family members stood up for the national anthem to pay homage to our country.



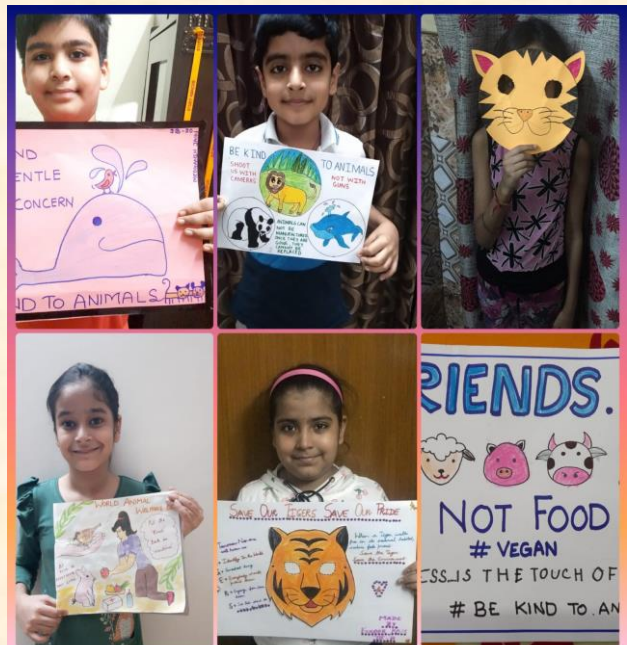
ASSEMBLY – WORLD ANIMAL WELFARE DAY

*Class III made posters on World Animal Day



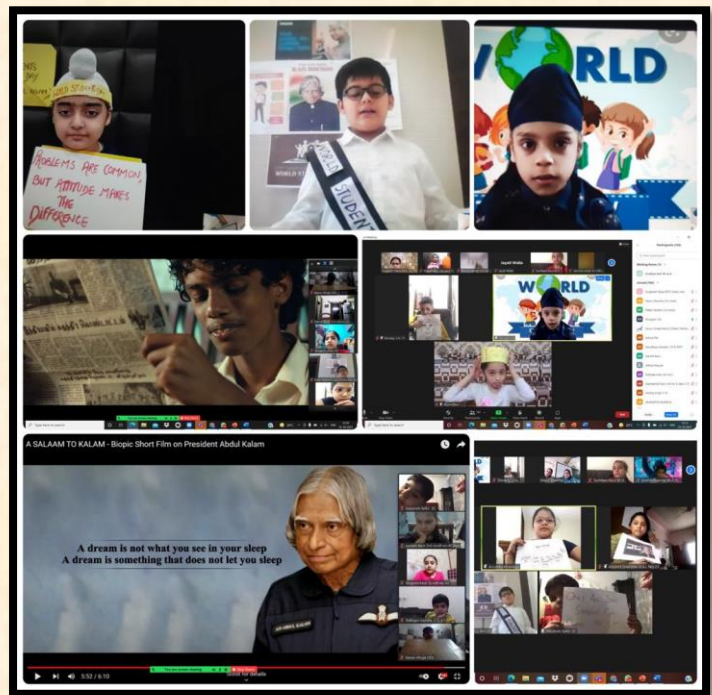
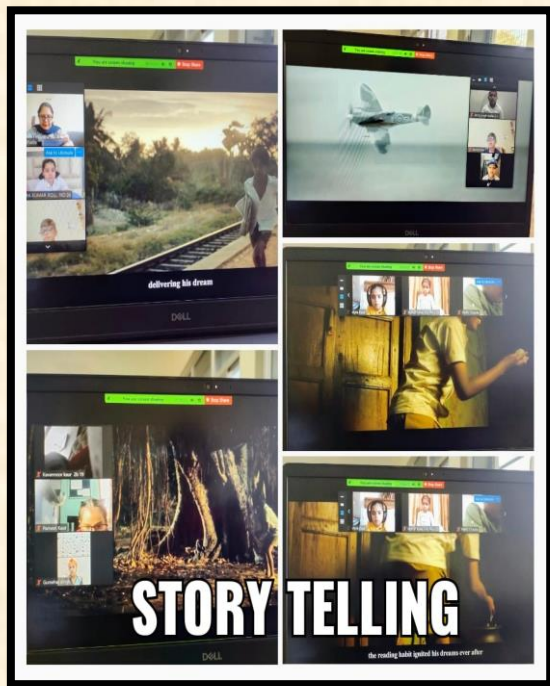


ASSEMBLY – WORLD STUDENTS’ DAY

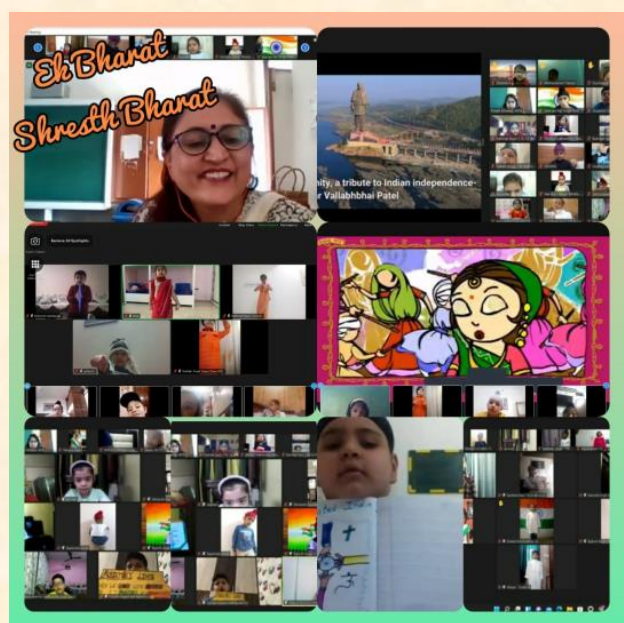


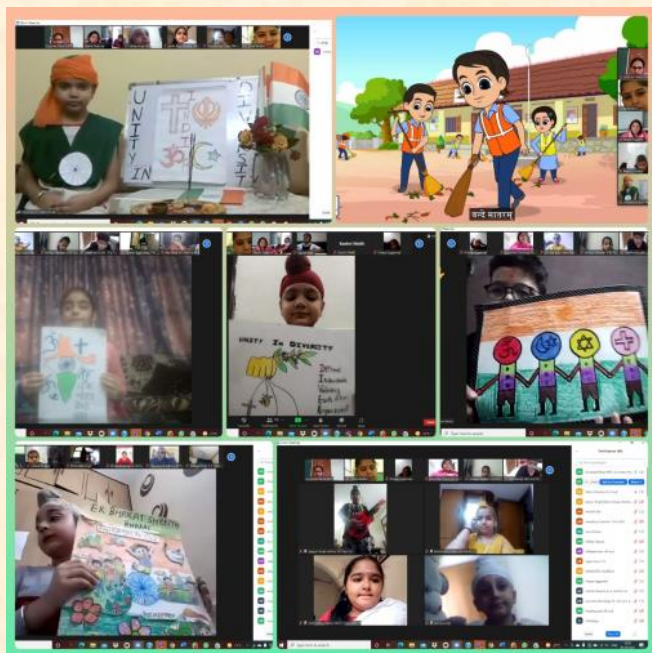


ASSEMBLY – EK BHARAT SHRESHTH BHARAT

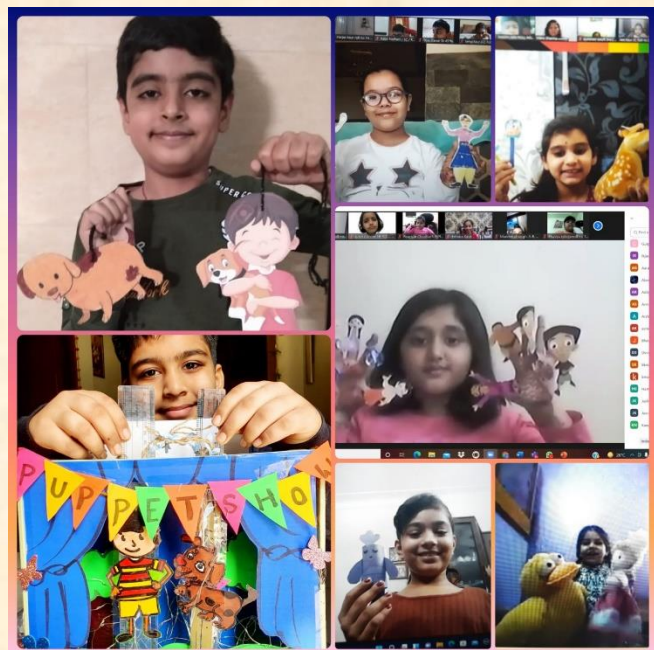
ACTIVITY – SHARE BOTTLE MYSTERY

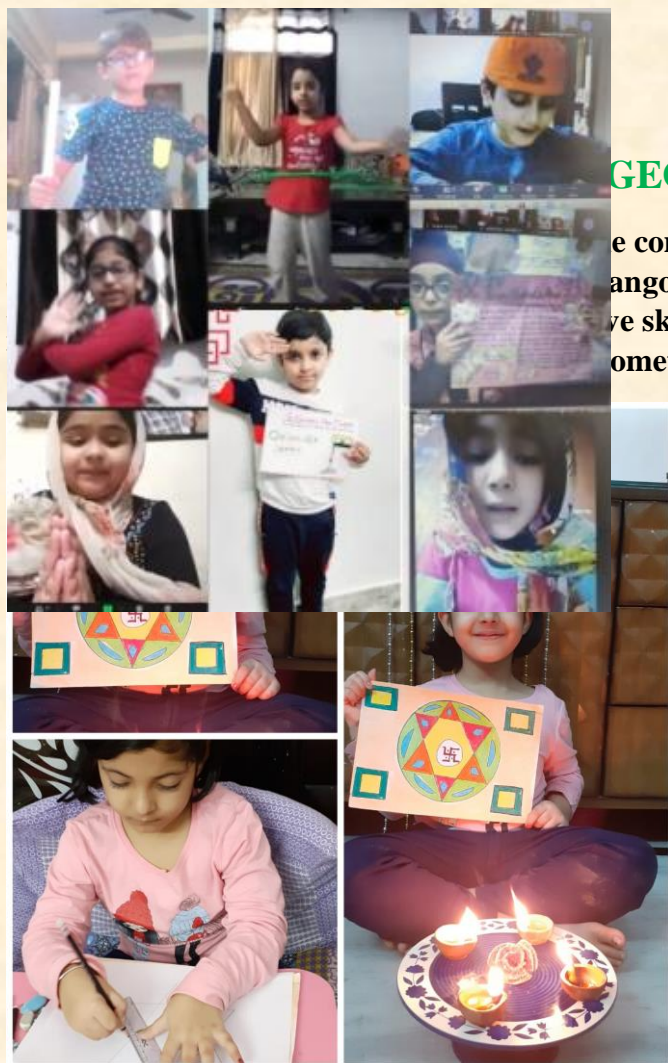

CLASS IV & V

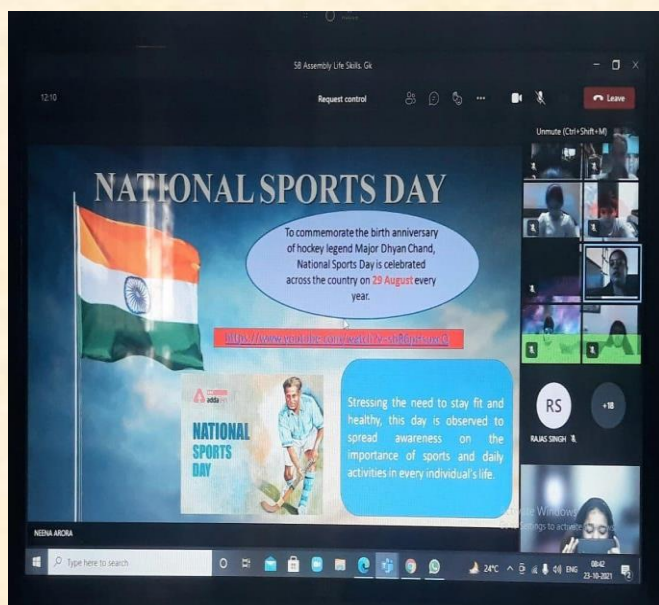
ASSEMBLY – GANDHI JAYANTI
