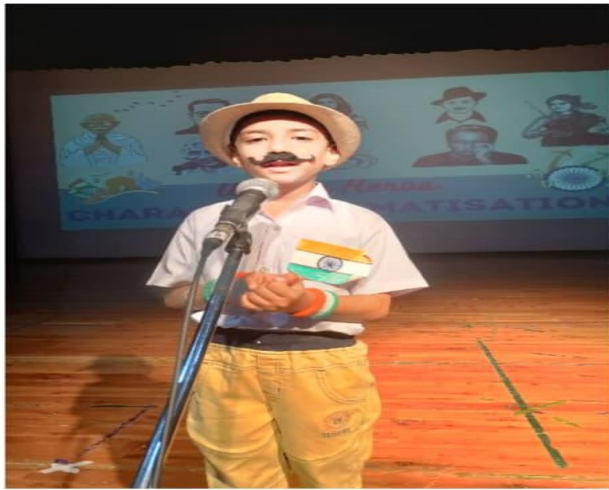
Unsung Heros-Character Dramatization Competition

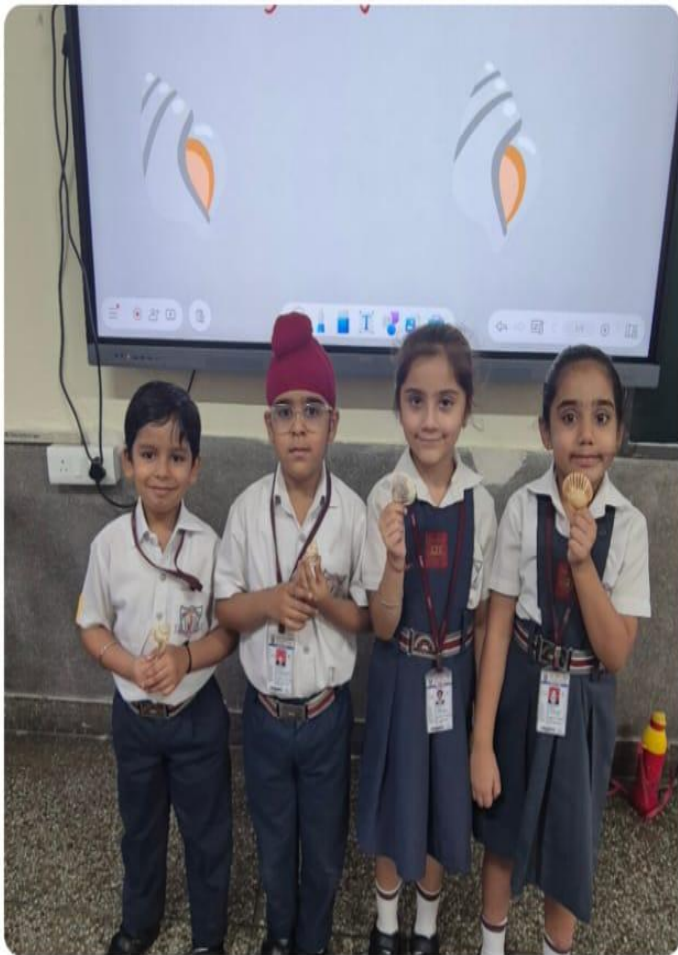
English Activity – Poem ‘Shells’

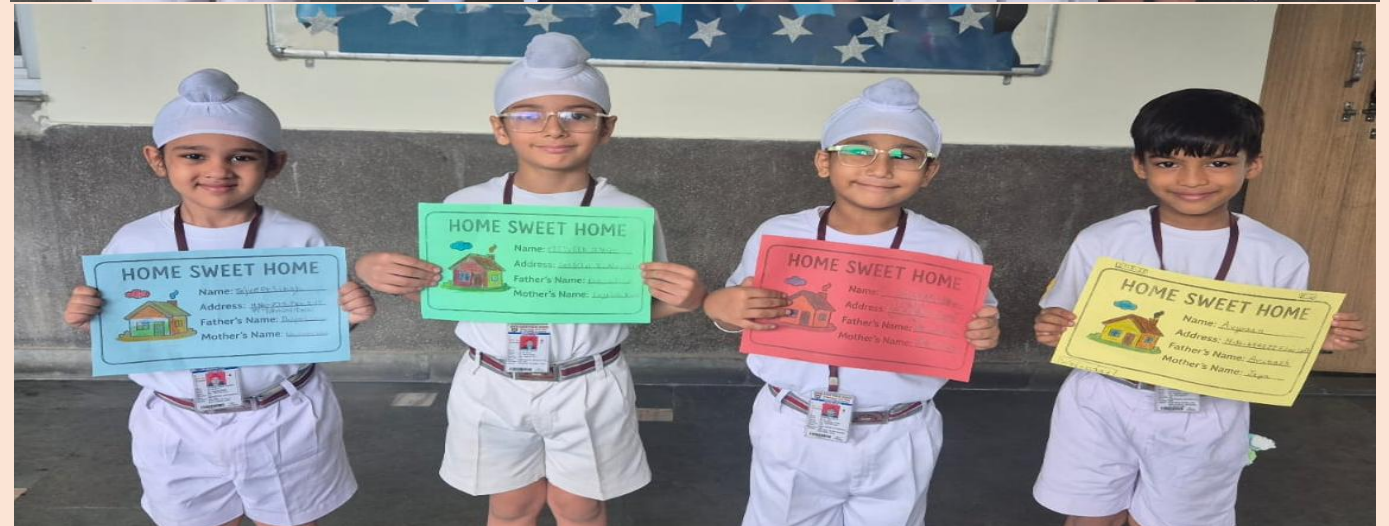
Name Plate Activity

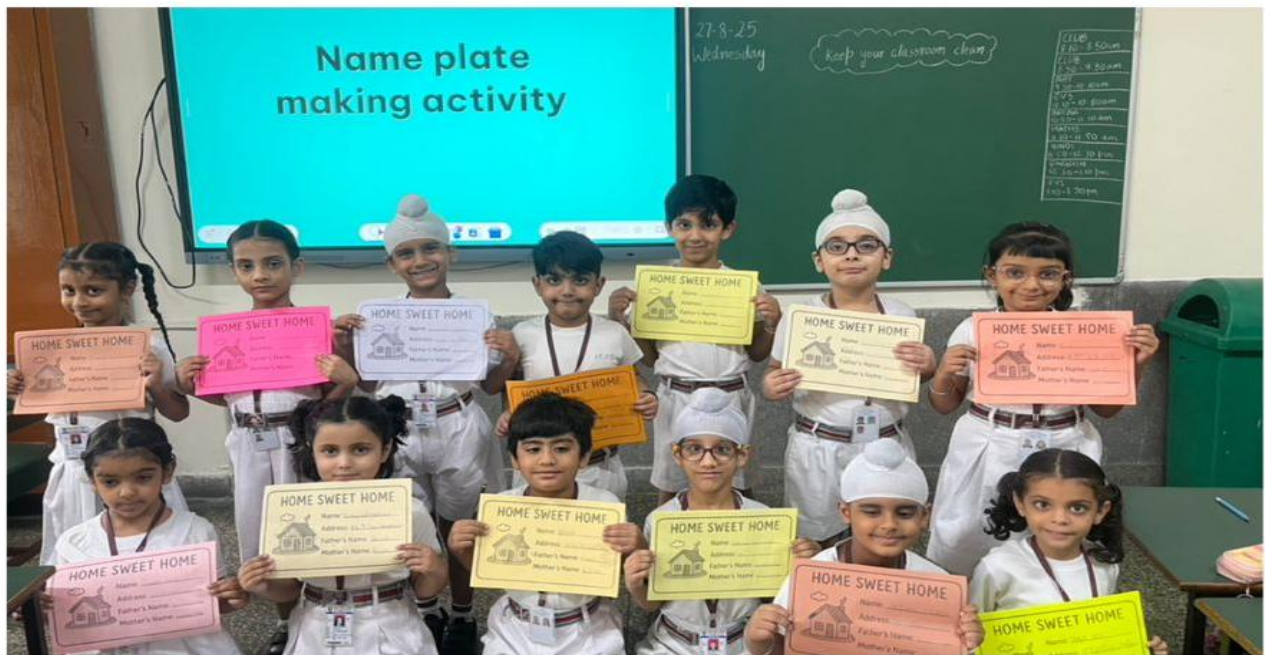

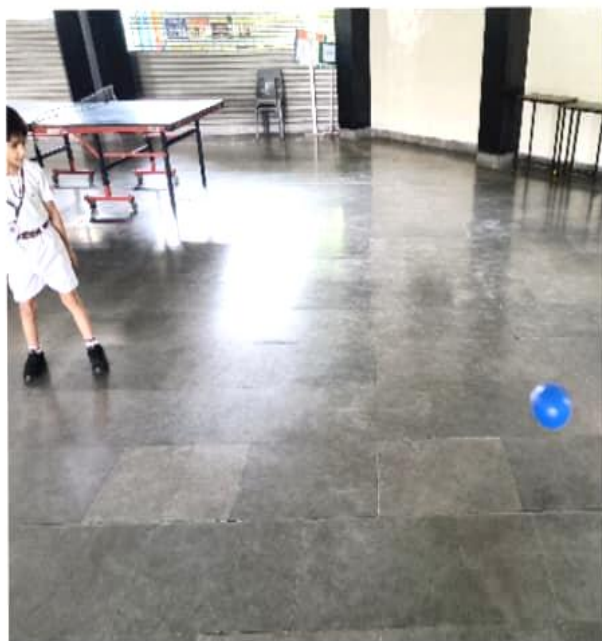
Knock and Subtract-Outdoor Activity

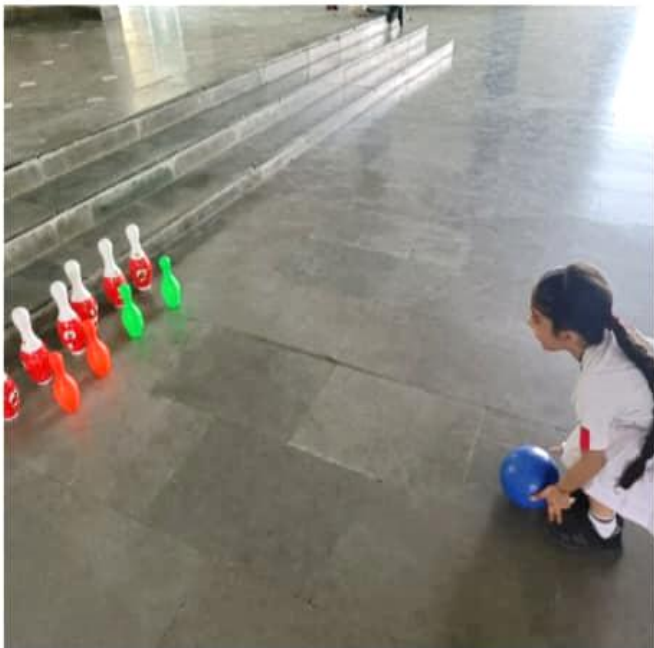

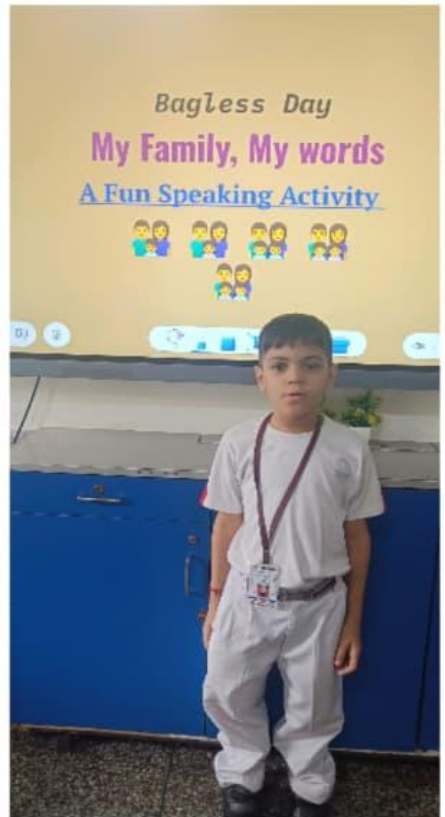


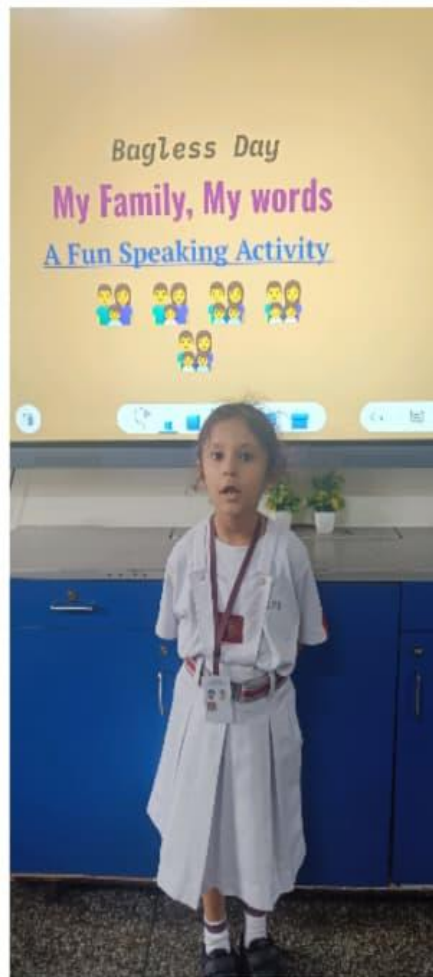
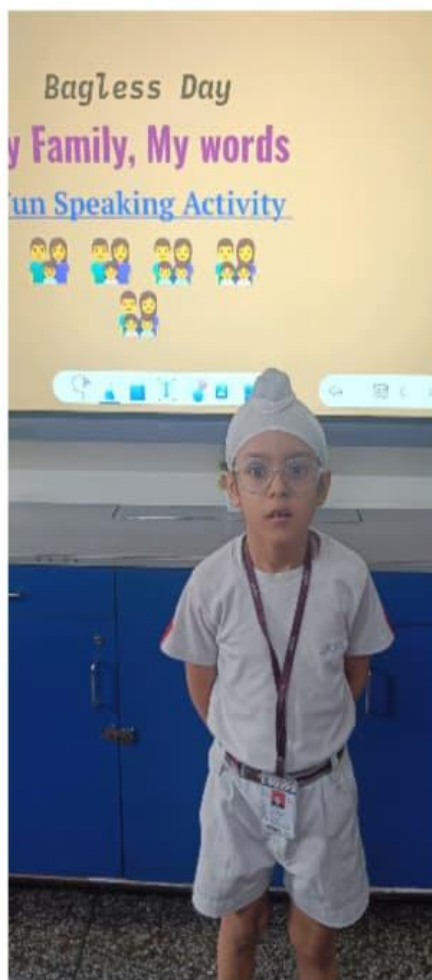
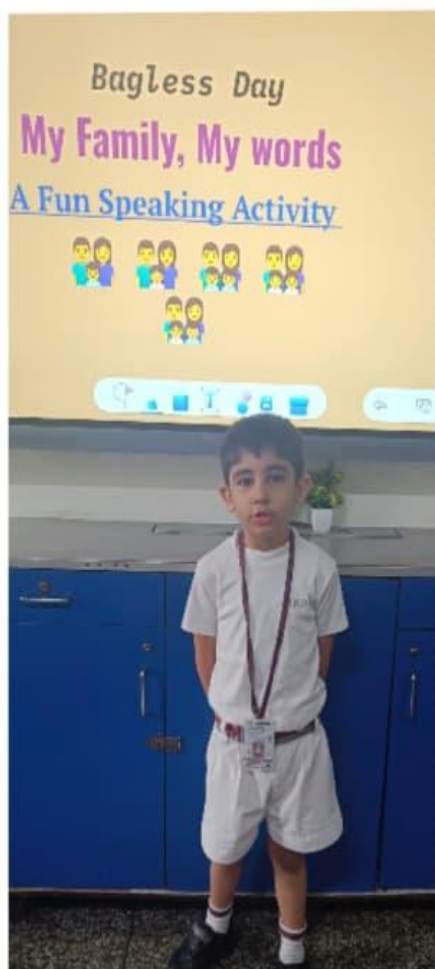


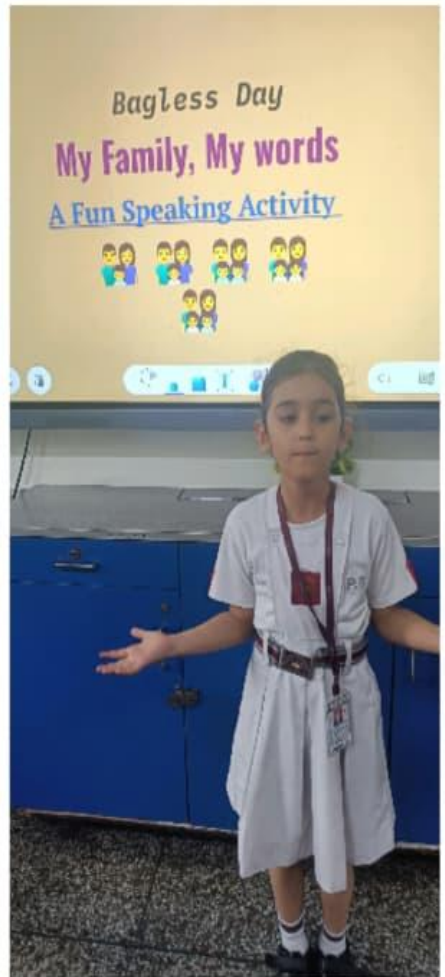
My Family, My Words: A Fun Speaking Activity

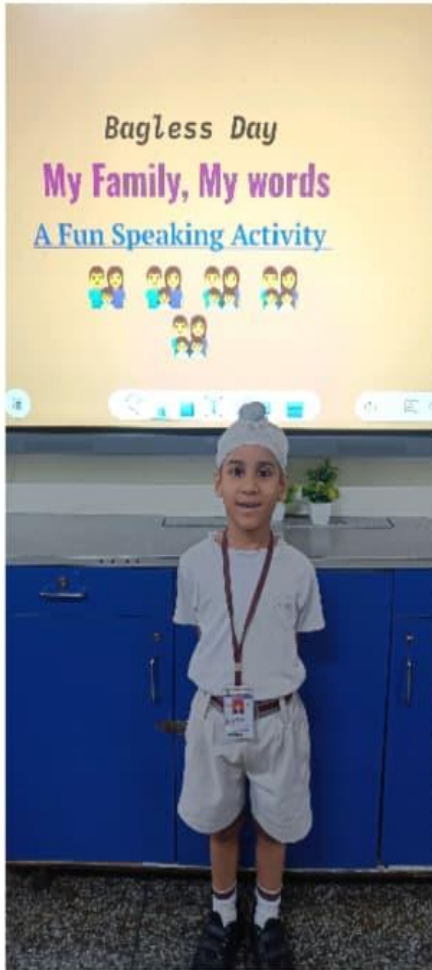

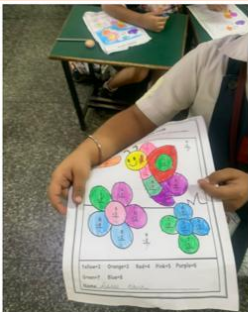




SUBTRACTION ACTIVITY

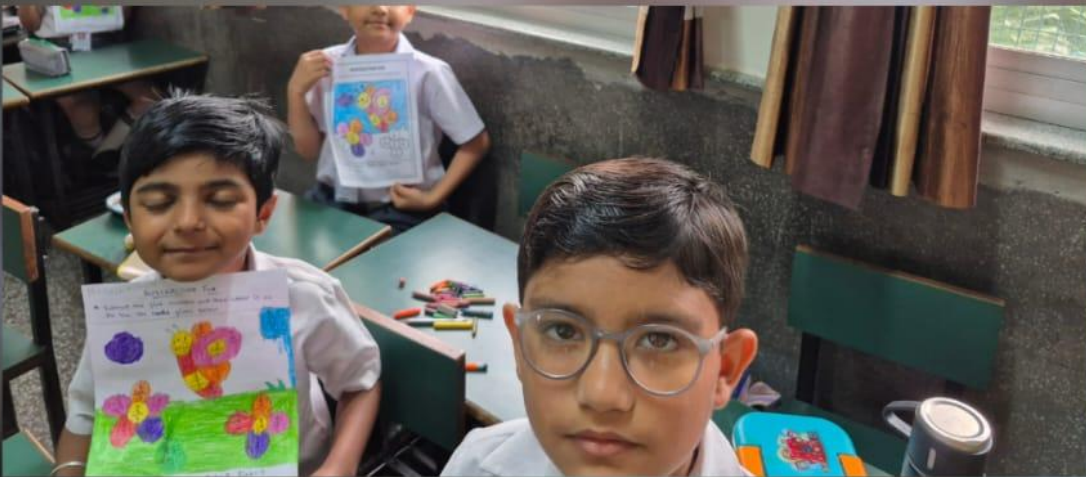

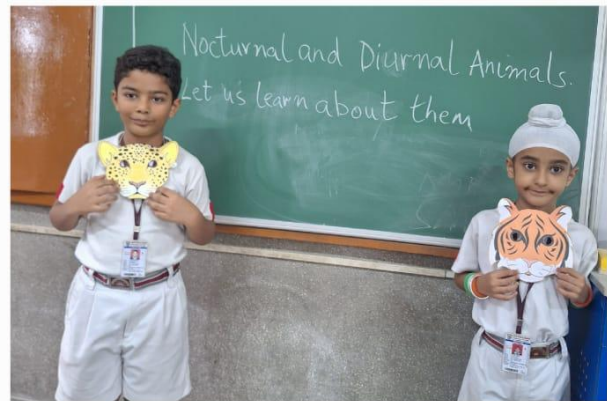
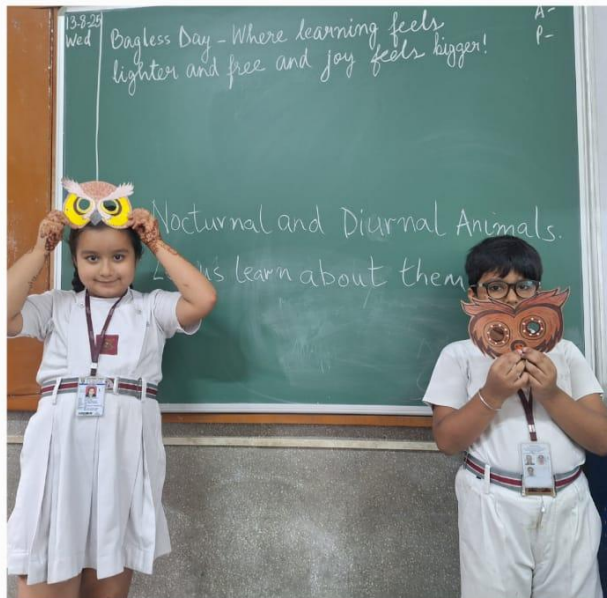


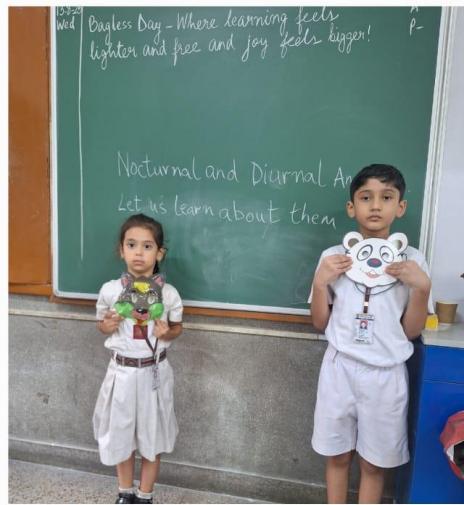
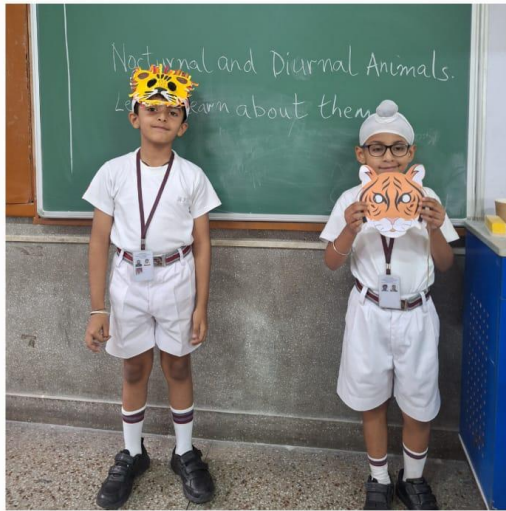




WHO COMES OUT WHEN

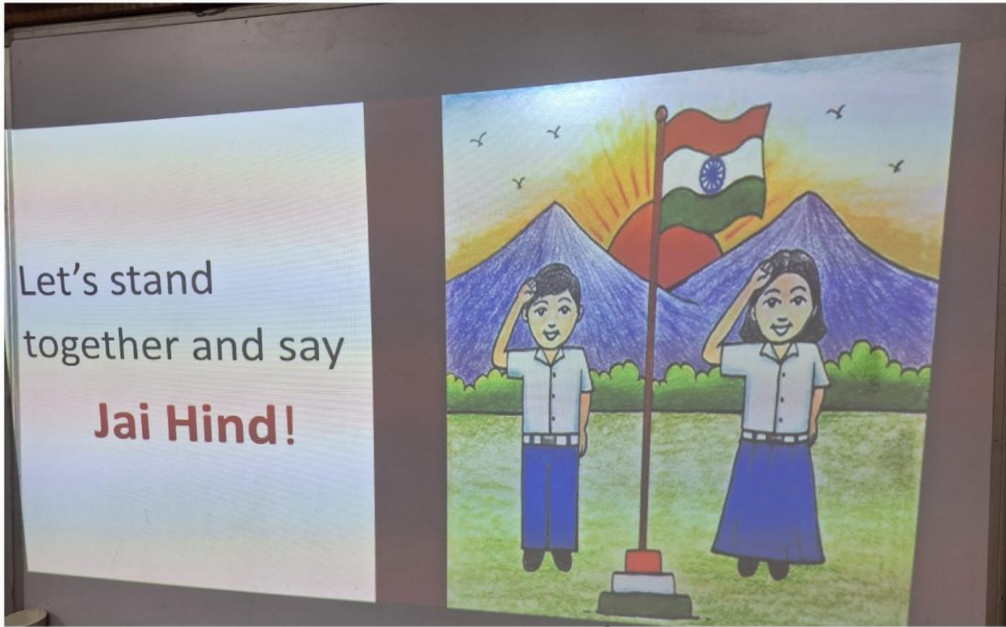




Colours of Freedom – Bagless Day Celebration

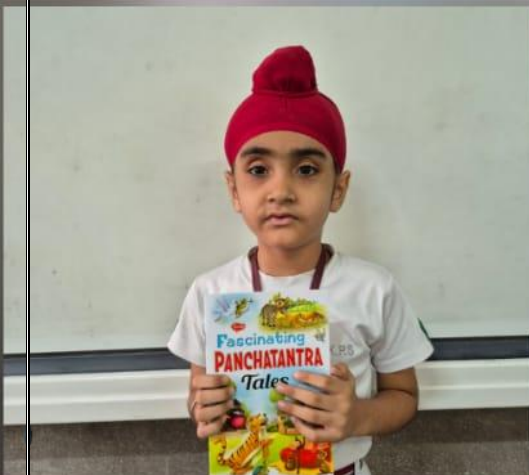
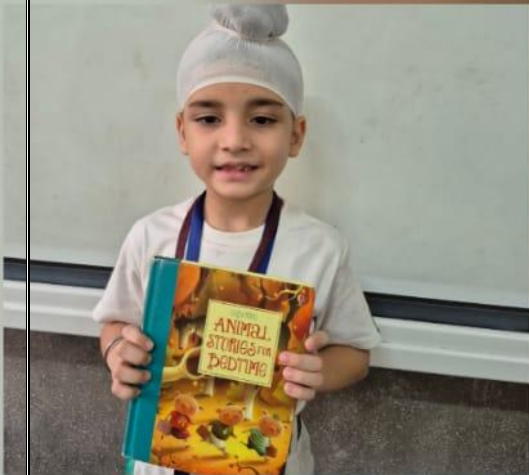
Show & Tell: My Favourite Storybook

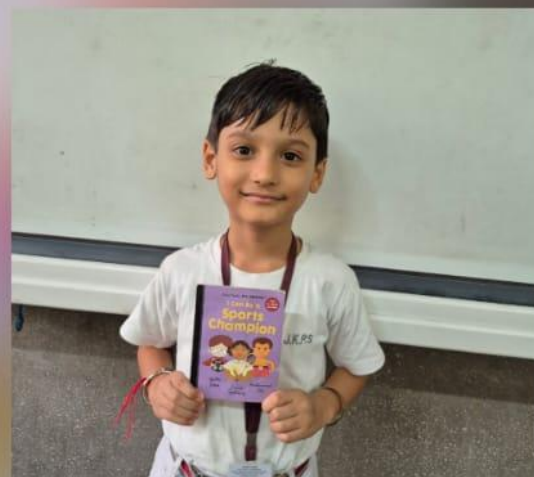
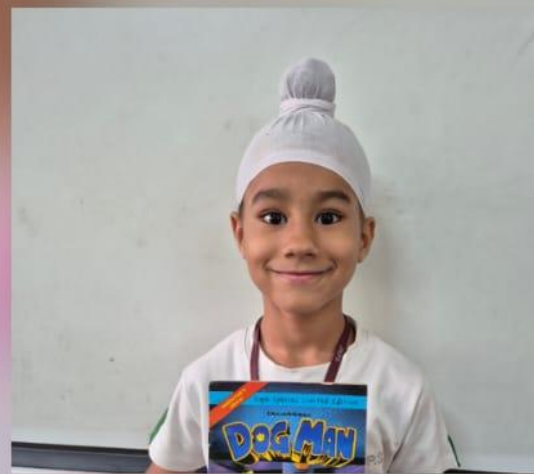
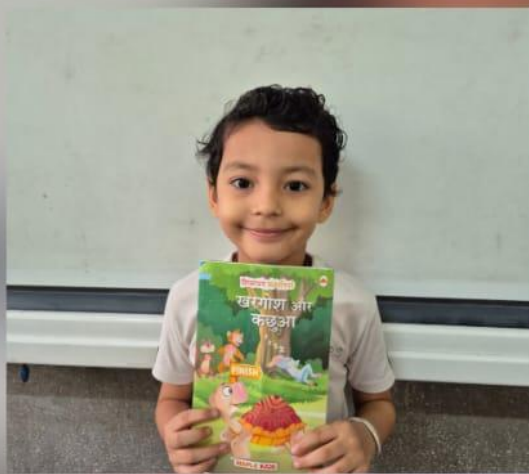
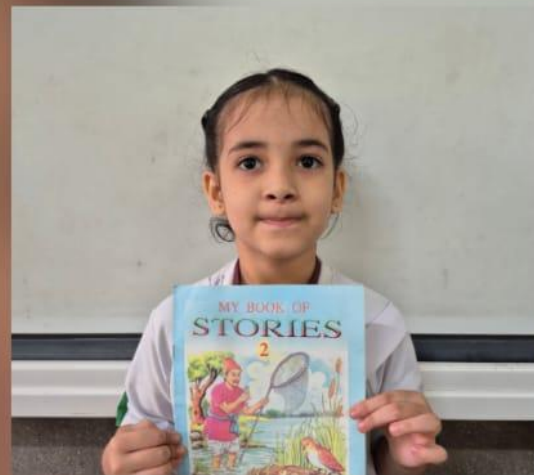
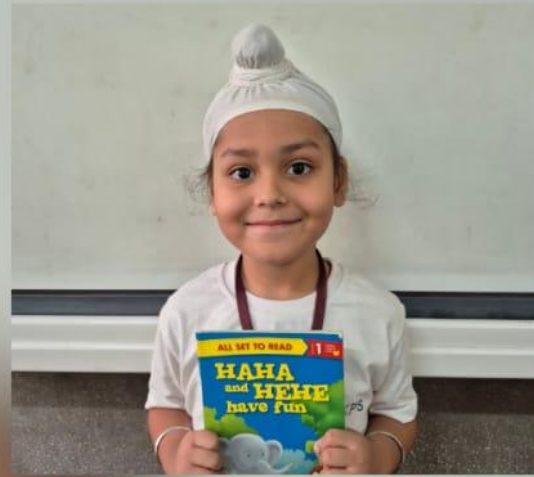

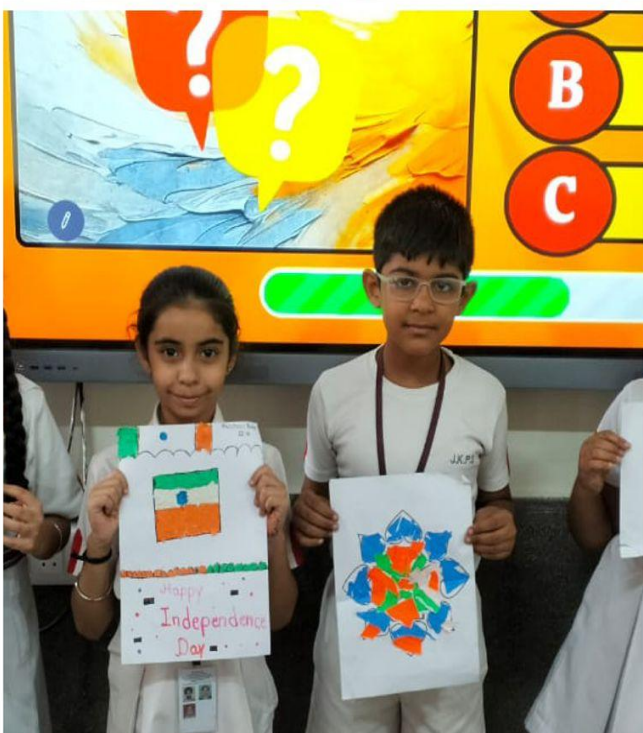






Har Ghar Tiranga – Tri-colour Rangoli Acitivity

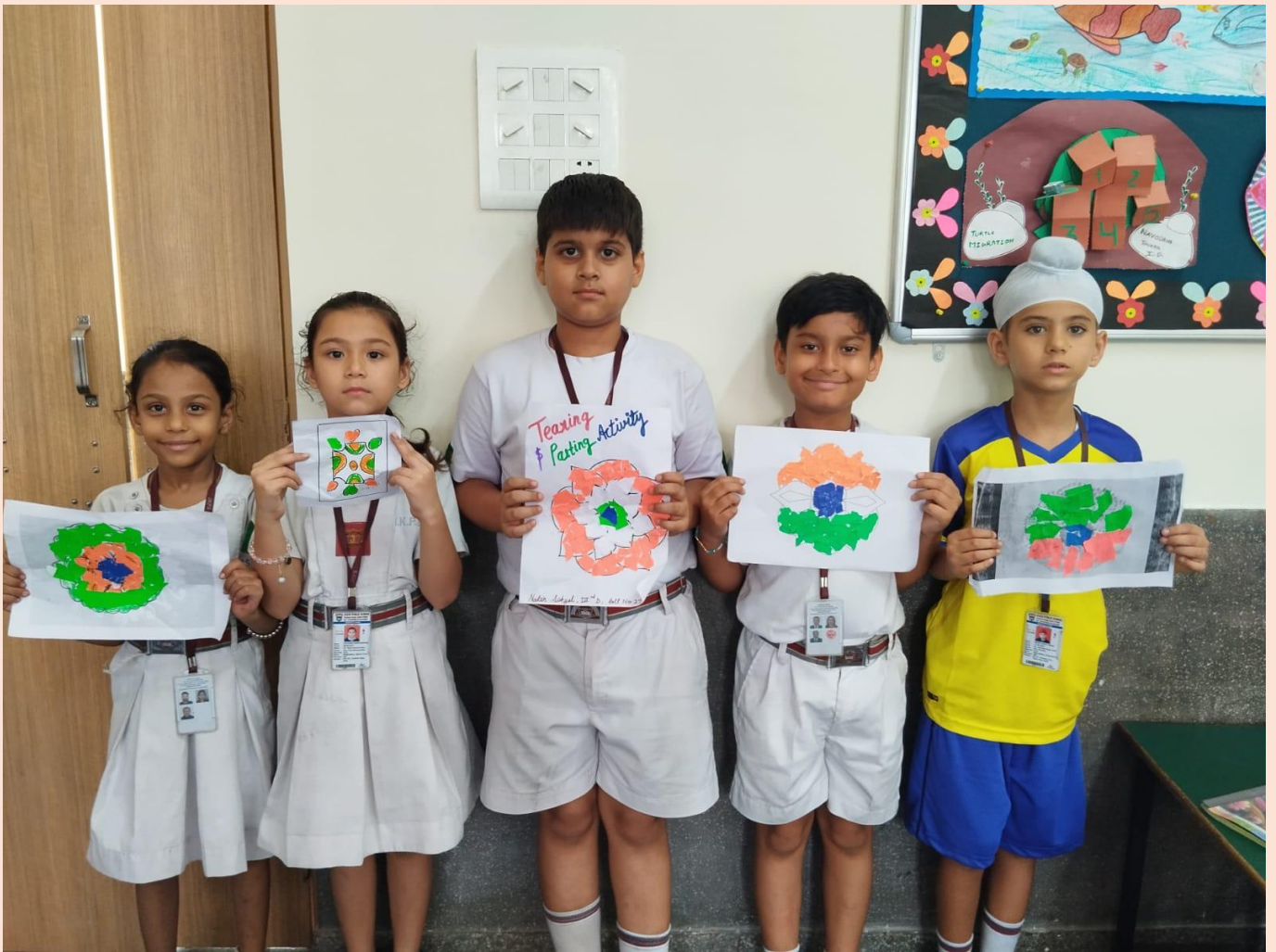












Annual Project Show
