BenQ Education DIDAC Workshop

A training workshop on the BenQ Interactive Board was conducted on **18 November 2025** by **Mr Saurabh Rawat**. The session aimed to familiarise teachers with the board's classroom applications and enhance digital teaching practices.

Mr Rawat began with an introductory demonstration of the BenQ Interactive Board, explaining how teachers can upload their teaching material and use the EZ Write tool for writing and annotations. He also showcased useful features such as the multi-window mode and ad-free video playback, which help in creating a distraction-free and engaging classroom experience.

The facilitator further introduced **Cloud Classroom**, a feature designed to improve student connectivity and classroom interaction. Teachers were also shown the process of reverse casting for online learning and the use of **AMS login** for secure access to personalised teaching resources. An additional highlight was the demonstration of exporting whiteboard content in PDF or image format and sharing it instantly through **QR codes**, making lesson sharing quick and convenient.

The workshop helped teachers gain a clear understanding of the Interactive Board's fundamental functions and the possibilities it offers for effective and modern teaching. The session ensured that participants were confident in accessing ad-free videos, using screen-split options, and sharing classroom notes digitally, thereby enriching their overall digital teaching experience.
