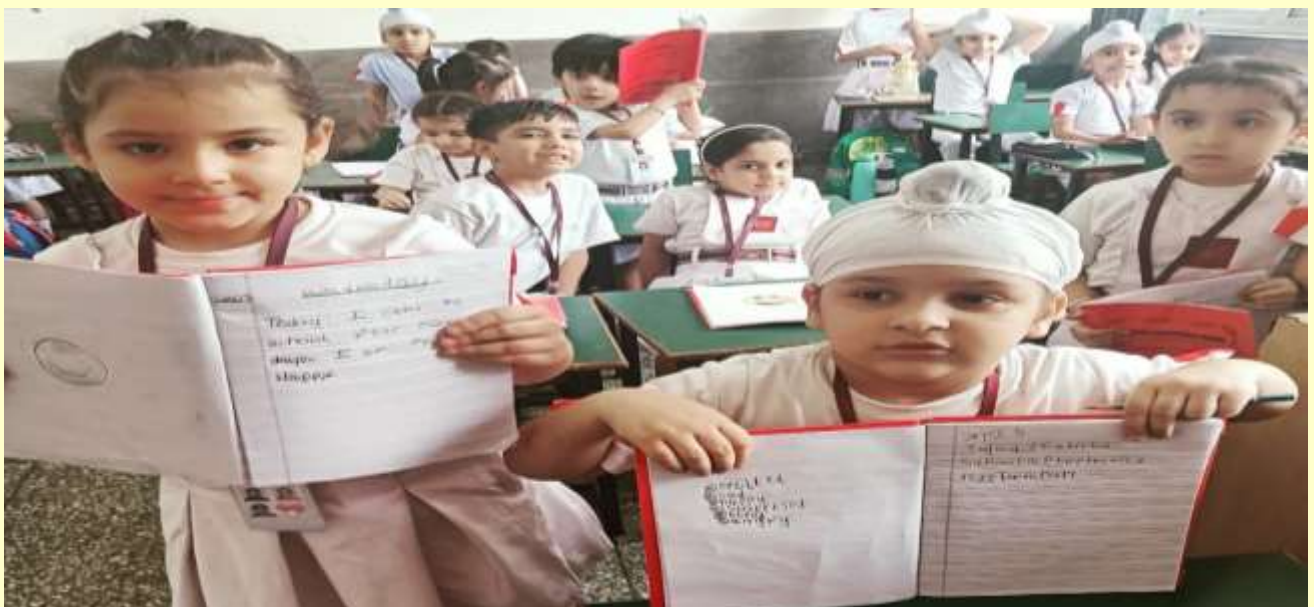

Welcome Activity

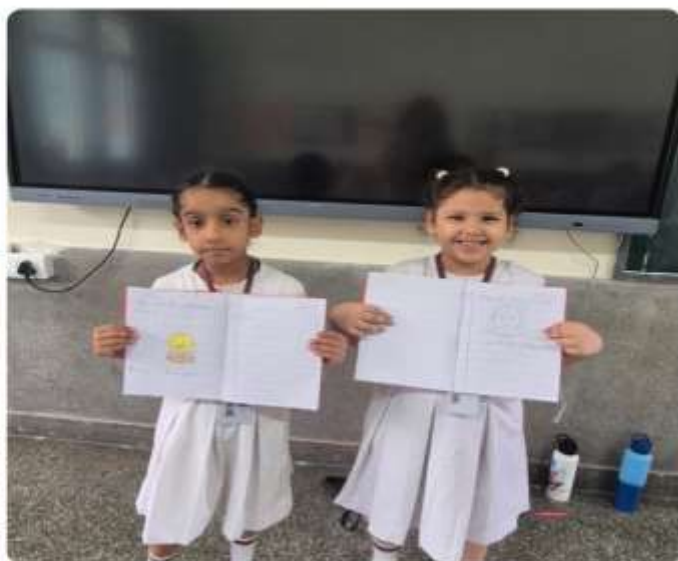

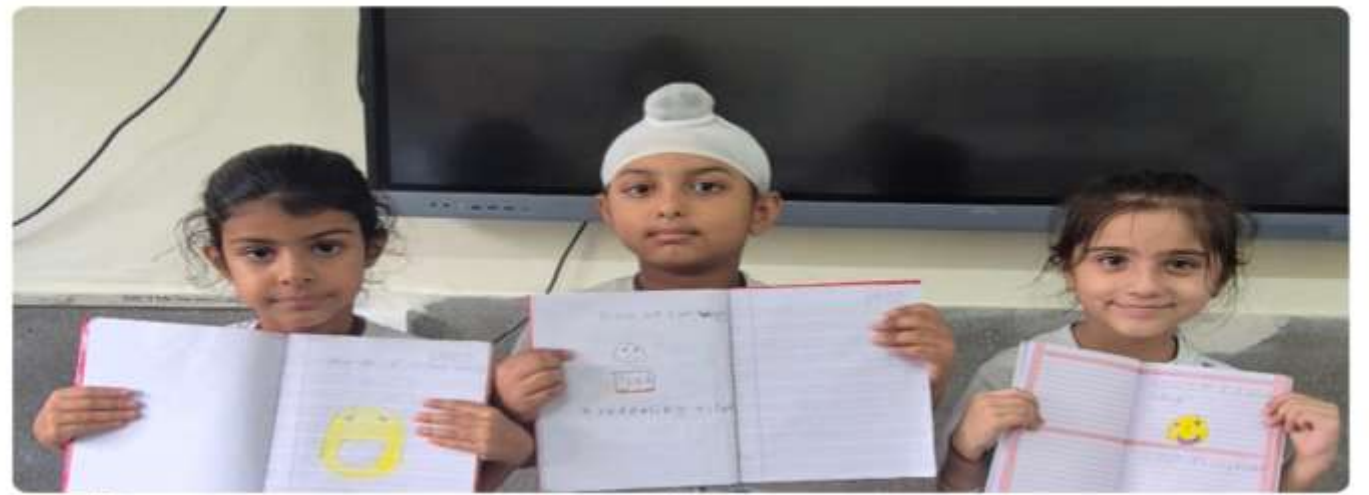
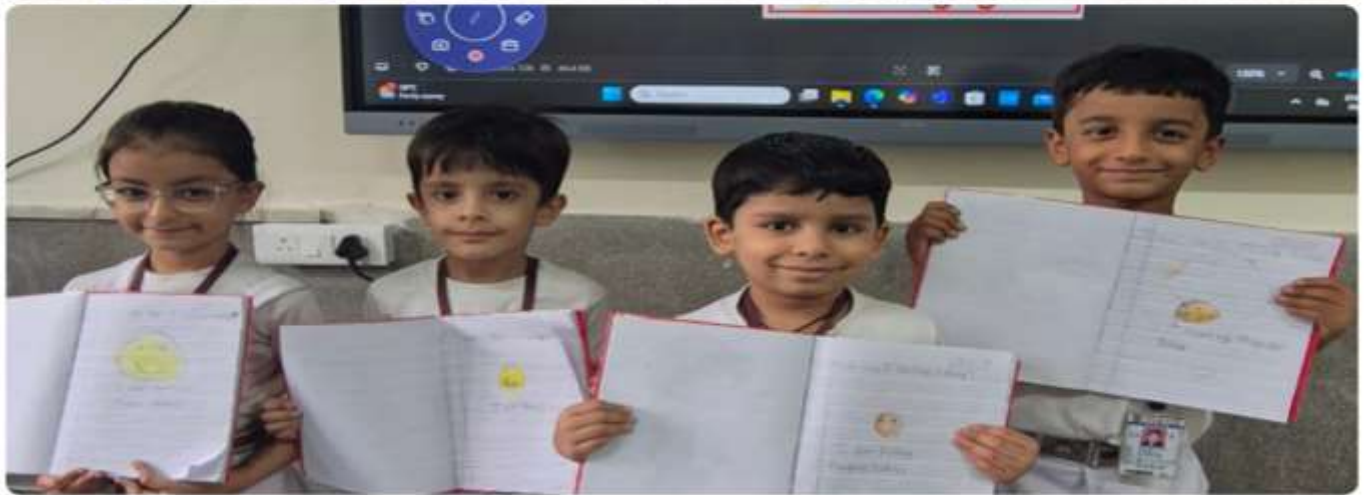

Show and Tell Activity- Clothes We Wear

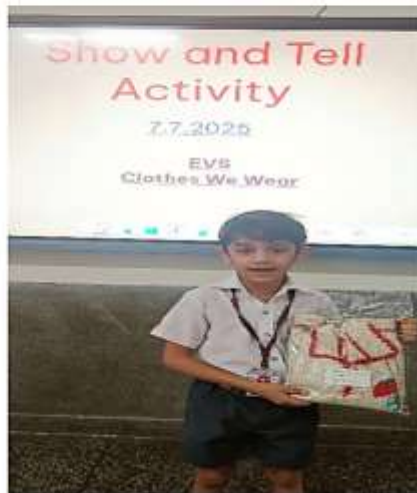

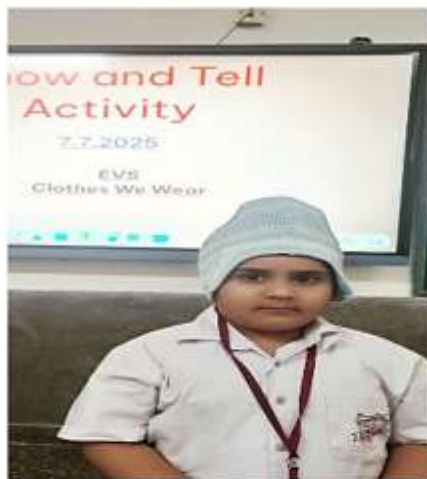

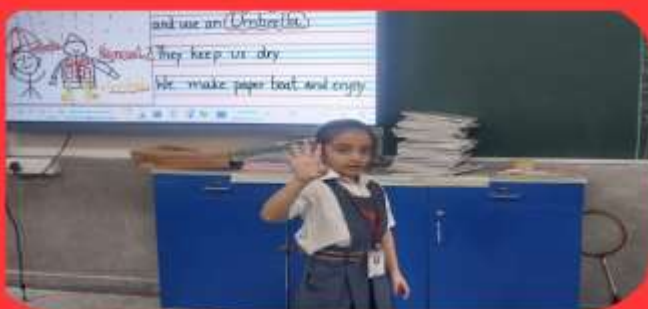

This interactive game helped children learn action words in a fun and memorable way, boosting their vocabulary, confidence, and observation skills. The entire class participated with joy and enthusiasm!

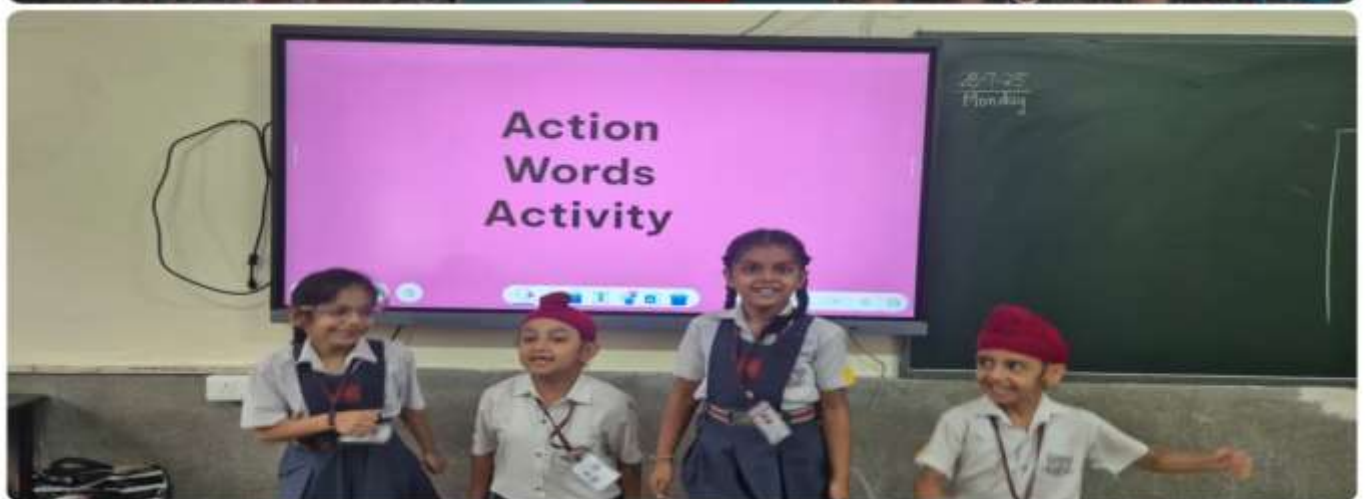

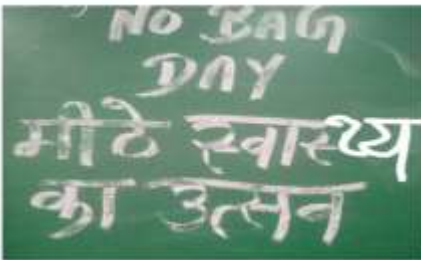




मीठे स्वास्थ्य का उत्सव

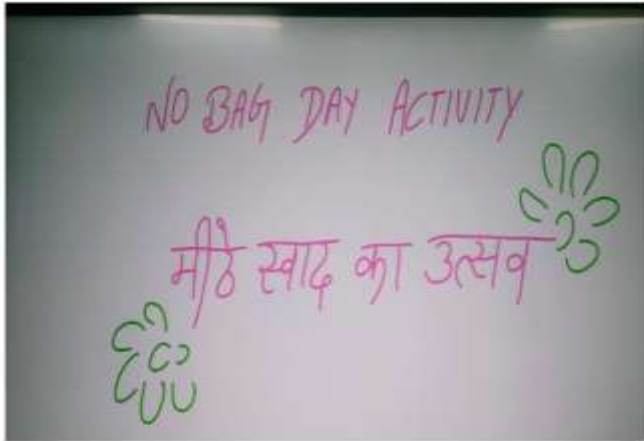

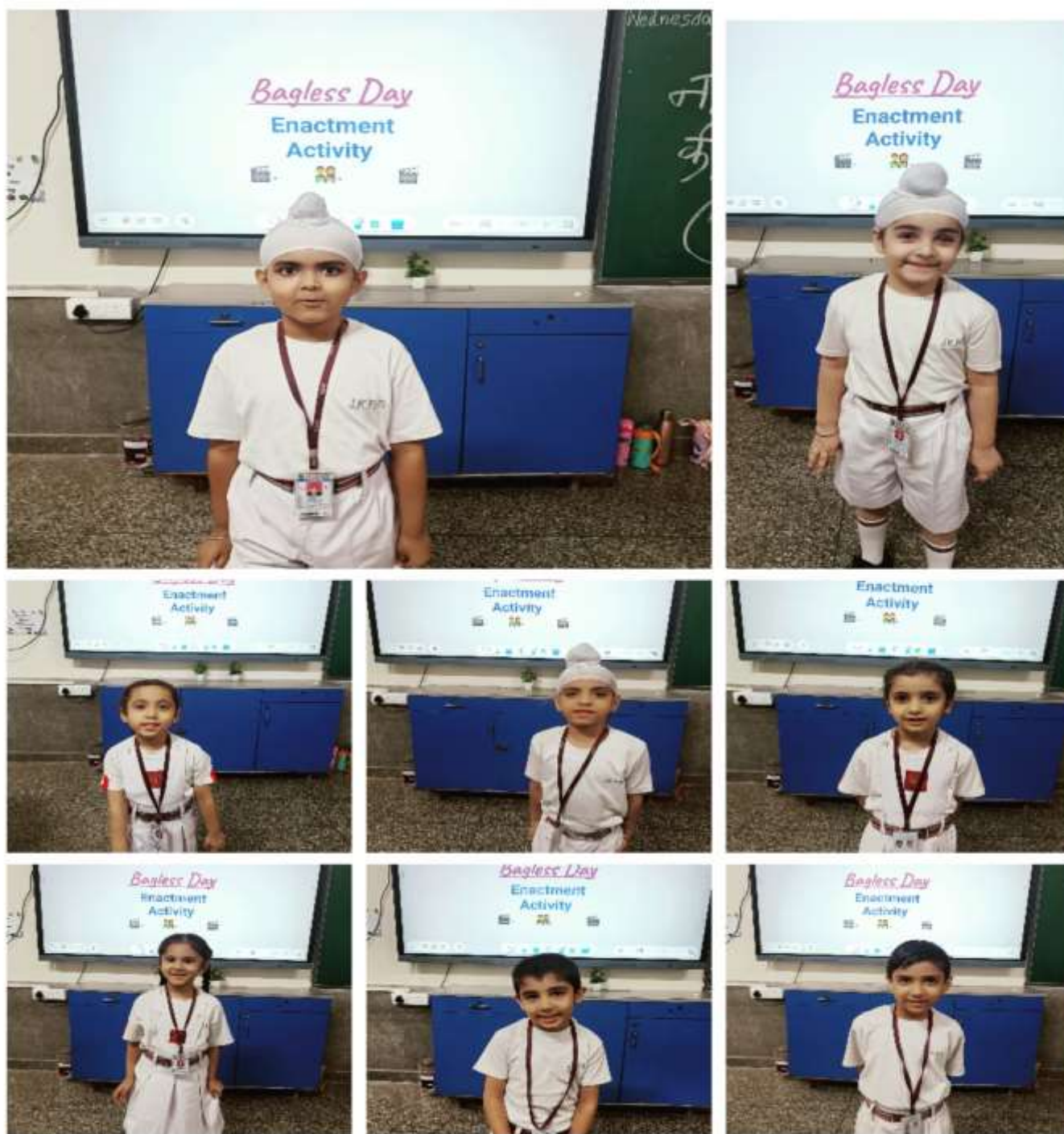

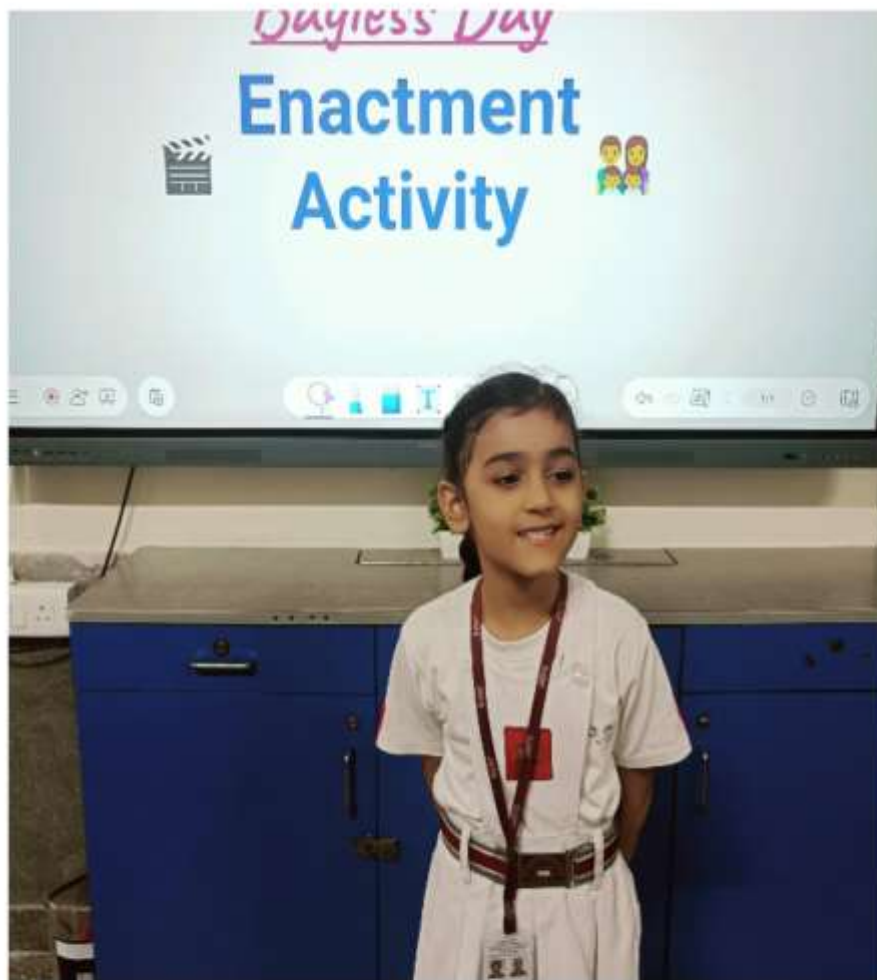
Enactment Activity

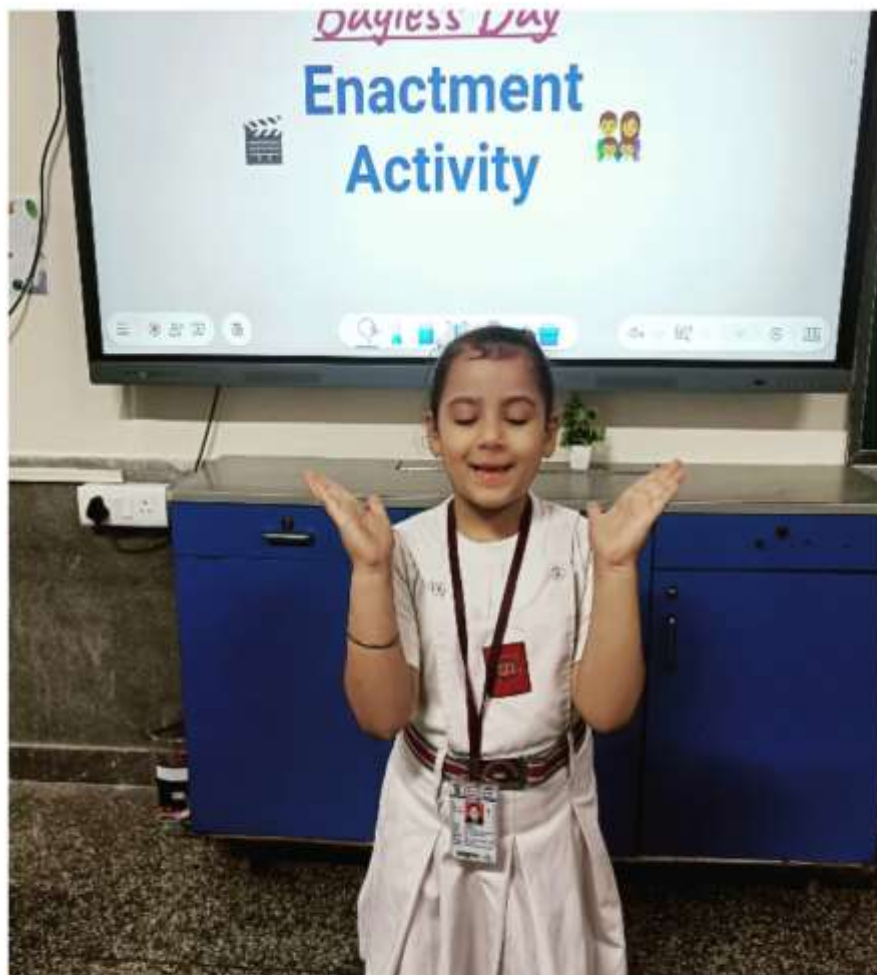

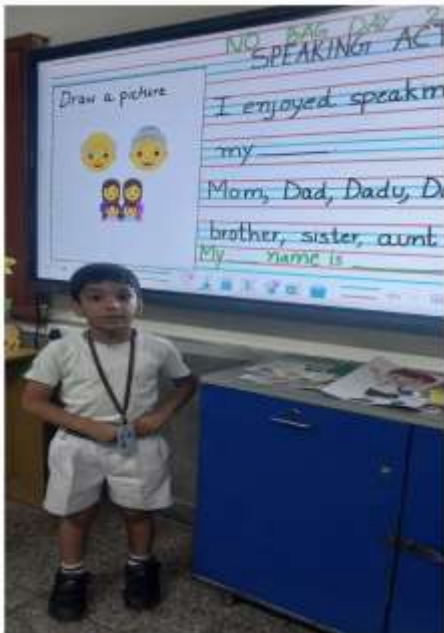

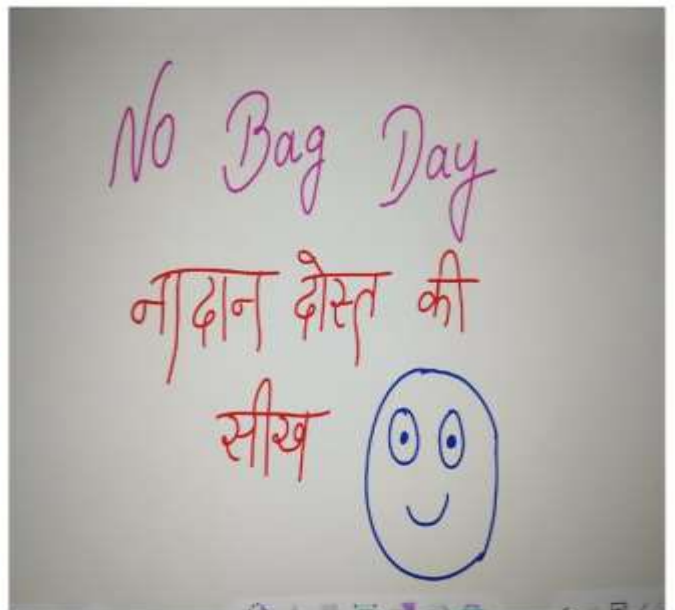

Crack the Code – Save the Horse!

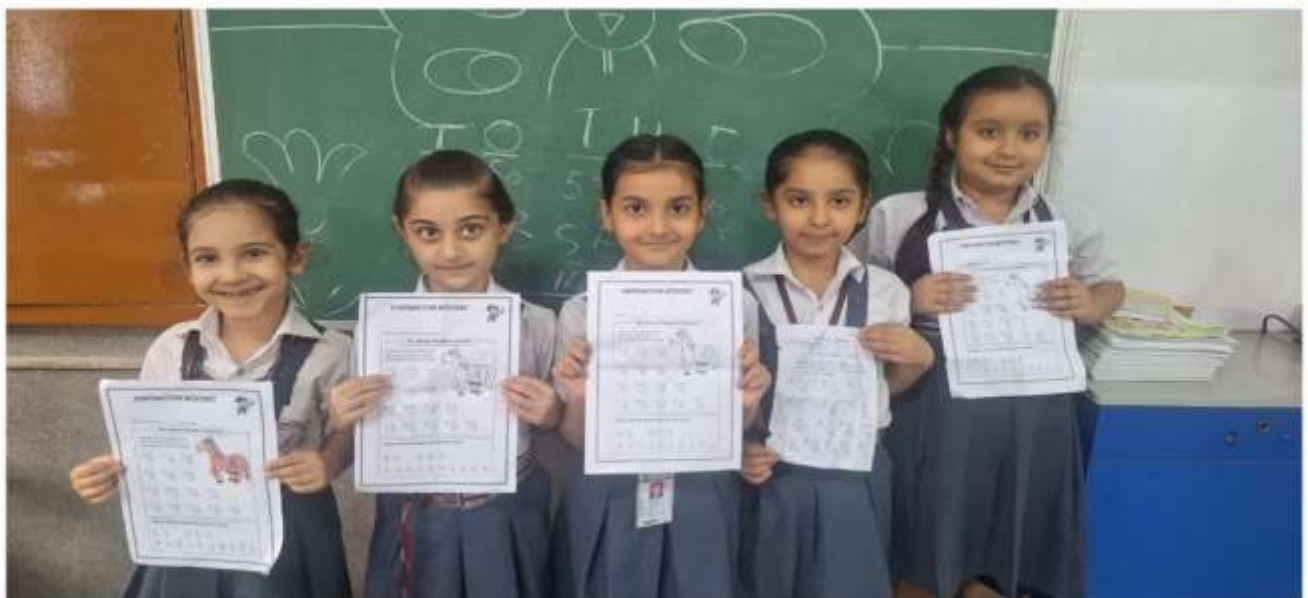

बैंगलैस डे गतिविधि – मीठे स्वास्थ्य का उत्सव

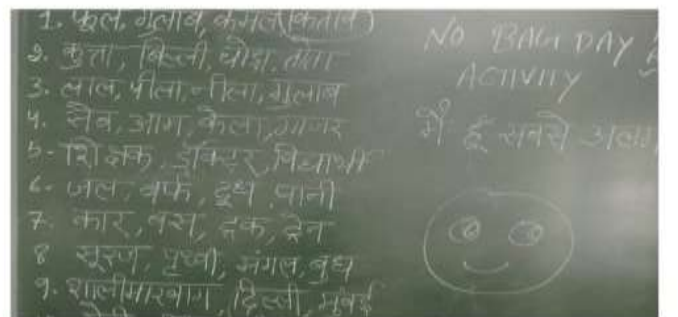
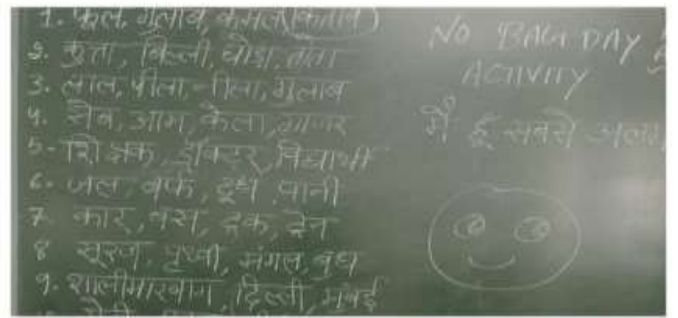
बैंगलैस डे गतिविधि – मीठे स्वास्थ्य का उत्सव कक्षा 2 के विद्यार्थियों ने बढ़ चढ़ कर भाग लिया। CBSE द्वारा आयोजित **Sugar Board Activity** के अंतर्गत इस गतिविधि का उद्देश्य विद्यार्थियों को प्राकृतिक और कृत्रिम मिठास के स्रोतों के बारे में जागरूक करना तथा उनके स्वास्थ्य पर पड़ने वाले प्रभावों की जानकारी देना था। इस गतिविधि में विद्यार्थियों ने दो प्रकार की वस्तुओं पर कार्य किया:

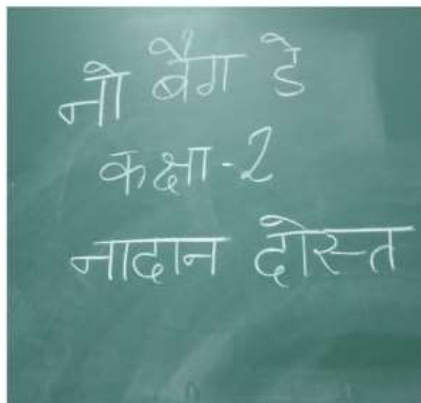


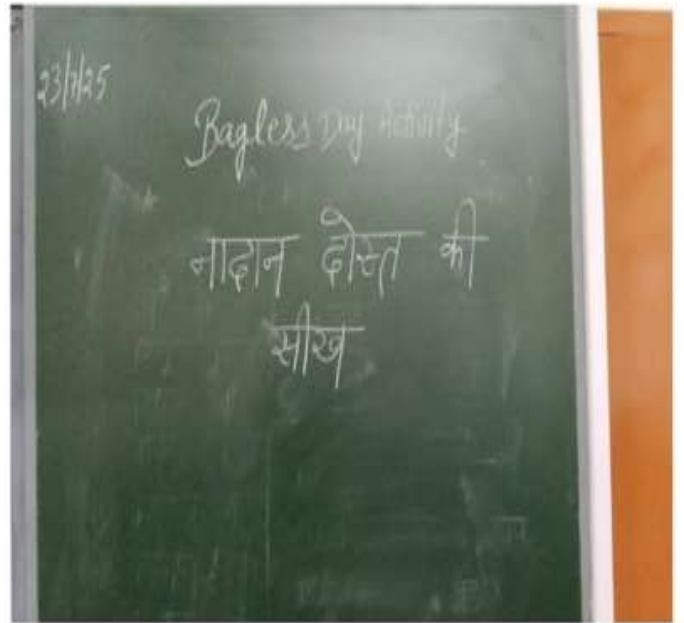




"चिड़ियों की ज़िंदगानी, कहानी की ज़ुबानी"

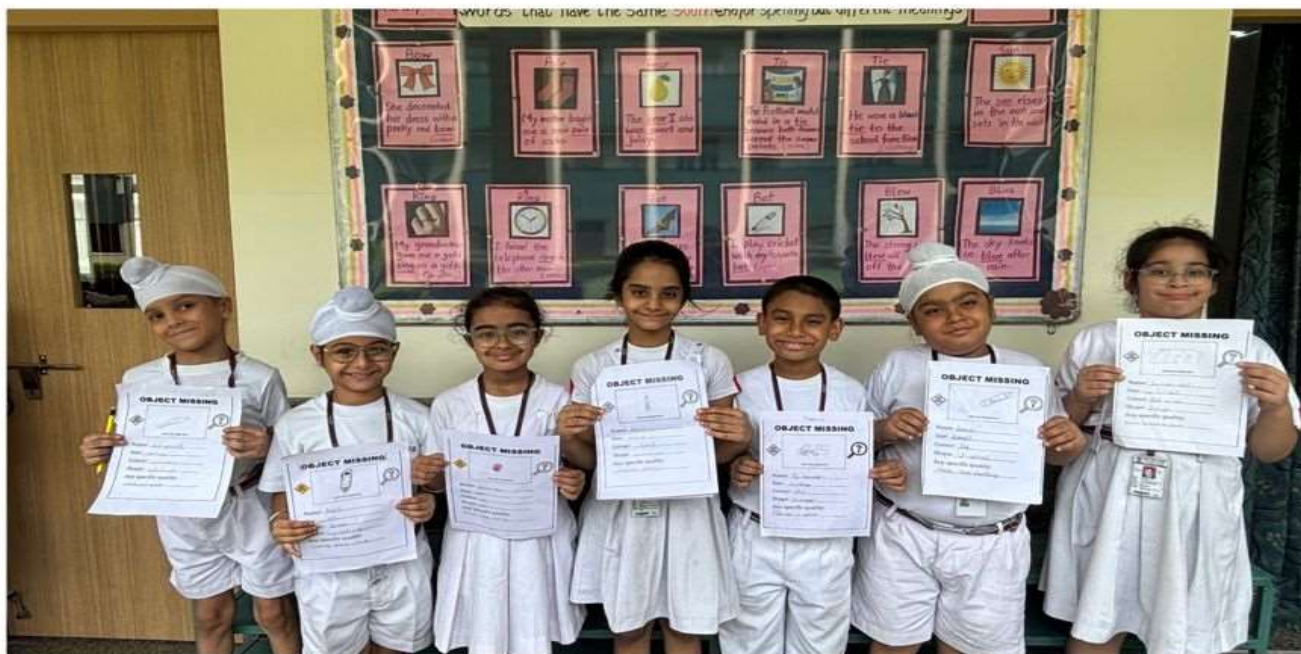
Bagless Day Activities (09.07.2025)

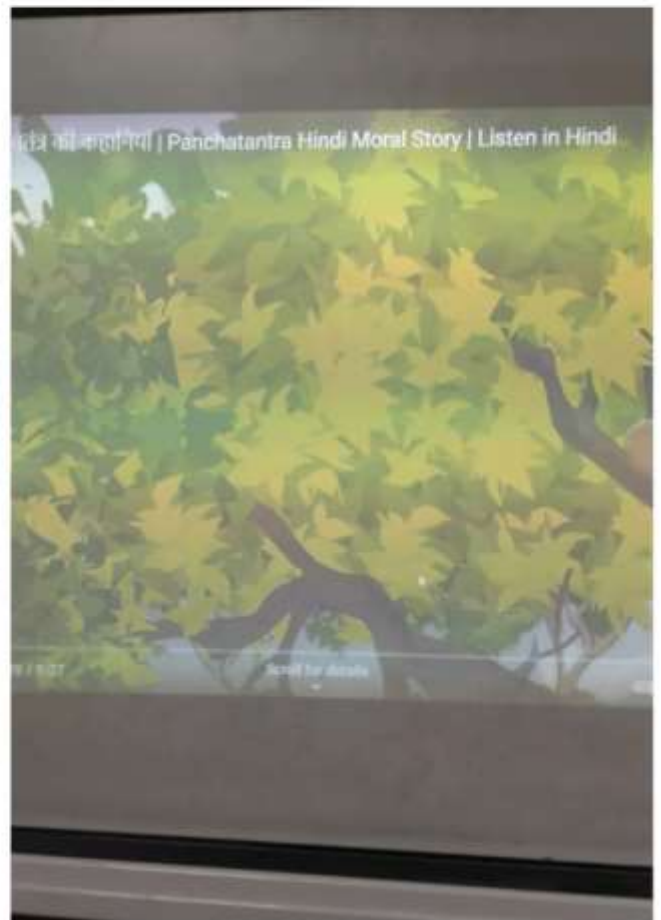
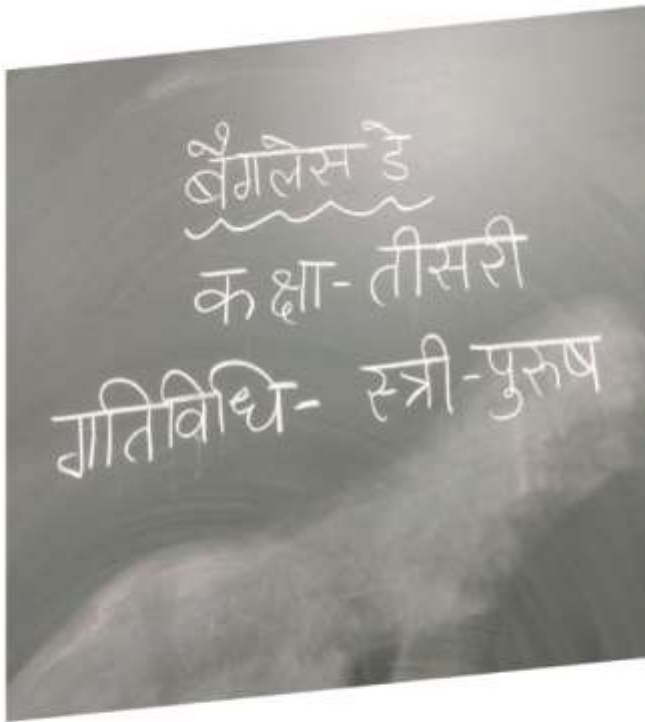
"सुनो और पहचानो – लिंग वाले शब्द" गतिविधि

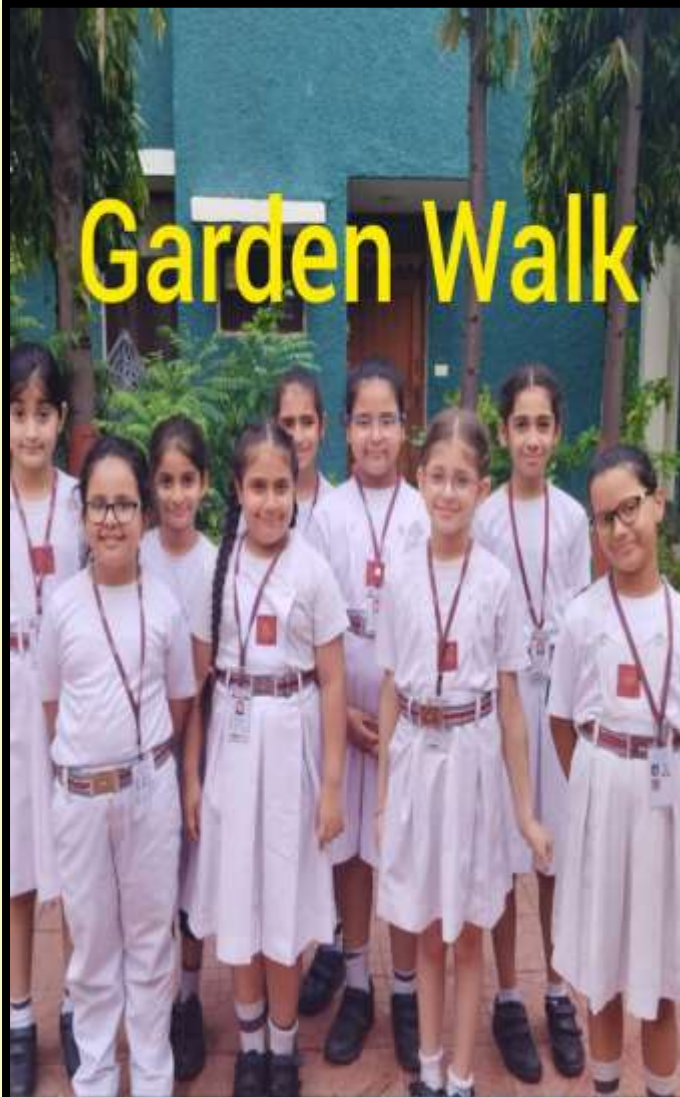

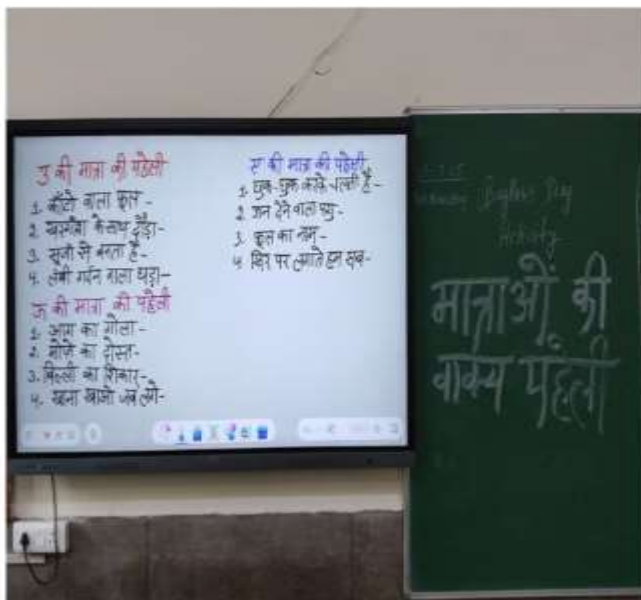
