








































































Dussehra Ravana Puppet Activity




















Diwali Art Celebration

































National Unity Day Celebration














Outdoor Activity: Hula Hoop Race
























SPORTS ACTIVITY


















October activity report







































"चित्र बोले, कहानी डोले" गतिविधि





























Report on Morning Assembly – Class 3
