For example, if a child picked the word jump, they would say, "Yesterday I jumped." The activity helped children practice verb forms, develop sentence construction skills, and improve their confidence in speaking. 











































































































































































## **BAGLESS DAY ACTIVITIES**






































# Paper clip activity

On the occasion of Bagless Day, Class 1 students participated in a joyful hands-on maths activity titled "Count Clip and Play." Using colourful paper clips and a ruler, children explored the concepts of addition and subtraction in pairs. The teacher posed simple questions, and students represented numbers by placing clips of two different colours on the ruler. For example, to solve 5+2, they placed five red clips and two blue clips, then counted the total aloud. Similarly, subtraction was practiced by removing clips and finding how many were left. The activity not only made number operations visual and tactile but also turned abstract concepts into a playful and memorable experience. Working in pairs encouraged cooperation, communication, and active participation, making mathematics both fun and meaningful for the young learners.































































# ASSEMBLIES Teacher's Day Assembly






















## हिंदी दिवस पर शब्द माला खेल का आयोजन















