# MUSEUMS AT THE RED FORT COMPLEX

A site Museum unlike other museums is built at a historical site. The objects are curated and displayed within structures that exist at the site. The Red Fort, a monument from the 17th Century, is a symbol of independent India. This World Heritage site houses many museums. Students work at the Drishyakala museum, that has a collection of original art works of renowned Indian artists, at the Swatantrata Sangram Sanghralaya, which provides a glimpse of major phases of India's struggle for freedom and at the Archaeological Museum.

This programme will run from Saturday 1st June to Friday 7th June 2024, from 10.00 am to 2.00 pm. Students report at the Red Fort. They work within the fort and museum premises, in groups, in pairs and individually. They are closely supervised by an ITIHAAS Team leader.

Against the back drop of the magnificent fort, they will create story boards, audio guides, activity kits for visitors. Explore the fort, beyond the obvious and study its architecture, with experts from ITIHAAS and A.S.I.

They will meet professionals, archaeologists, curators, conservators and archivists. For the culmination they will curate a walk and take visitor around. A certificate will be given on successful completion of the programme.
