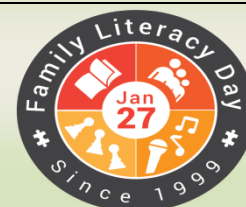
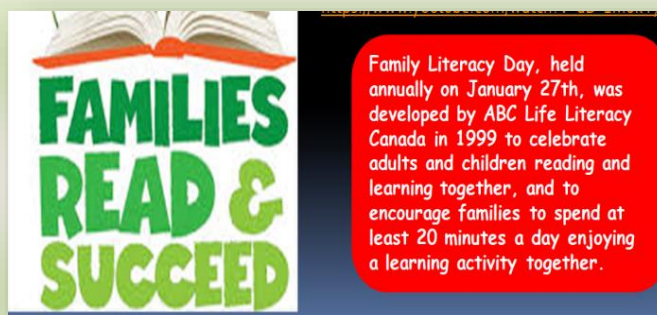


Report on Family Literacy Day

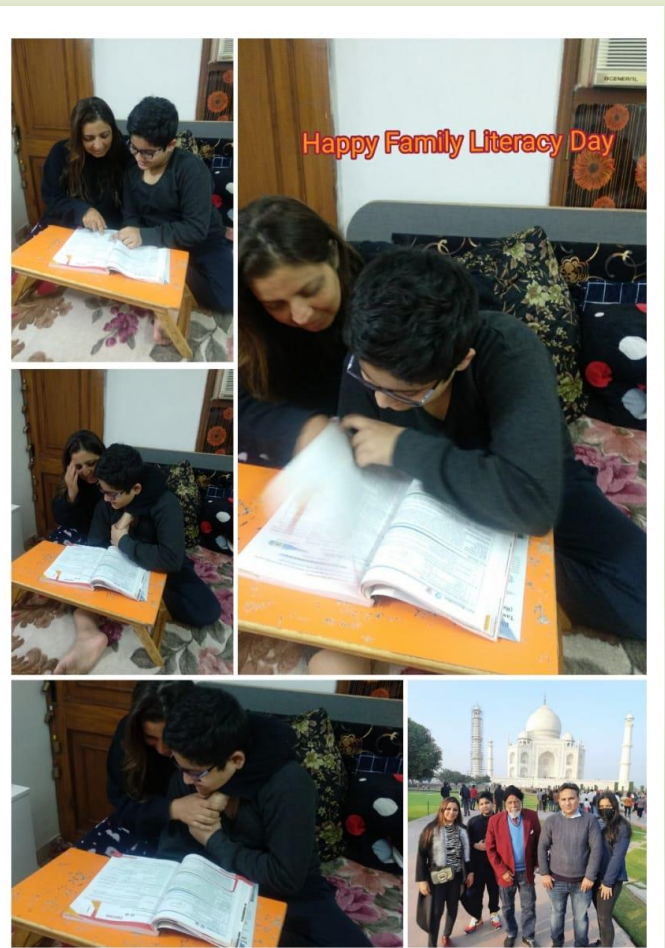


“Reading should not be presented to children as a chore or duty. It should be offered to them as a precious gift”
